Guidelines to Authors

All the submitted papers to JMEIT are subject to a blind peer-review process. After receiving the comments from the reviewers, the editorial board will be shortlisted the papers for the publication in the journal. Only reviewers' decision is final for the publication. All the papers should have 150 words of abstract and appropriate key words. Papers are accepted only in MS-Word format (Refer Guidelines). JMEIT charges \$ 35 (US Dollars) / Rs.2000/- (INR) as processing and publication fee for the accepted papers.

- Authors are requested to send the scanned copy of Filled Declaration Form with E-Signature, final version of the paper with appropriate publication fee.

- Submit your papers as only one attachment file (which contains the text, tables, figures, etc.)
- Authors are requested to send the papers with Proper Alignments according to the given format.
- The submitted article should include the name(s) and the affiliation(s) of the author(s).
- The attached file should not include any letter or message to editor / reviewer.
- Maximum no. of authors for a paper is restricted to **Three**. For additional authorship, **not exceeding Five** in total for a single paper, the journal charges \$ 5 (US Dollars) / Rs. 250/- (INR) for each additional author.
- Please do not send the same article more than once.
- After sending the papers, authors are receiving a mail from JMEIT as an acknowledgement.
- If any article found as Plagiarism, Authors concerned are fully responsible.
- Authors are requested to pay appropriate publication fee, if articles are shortlisted for publication.
